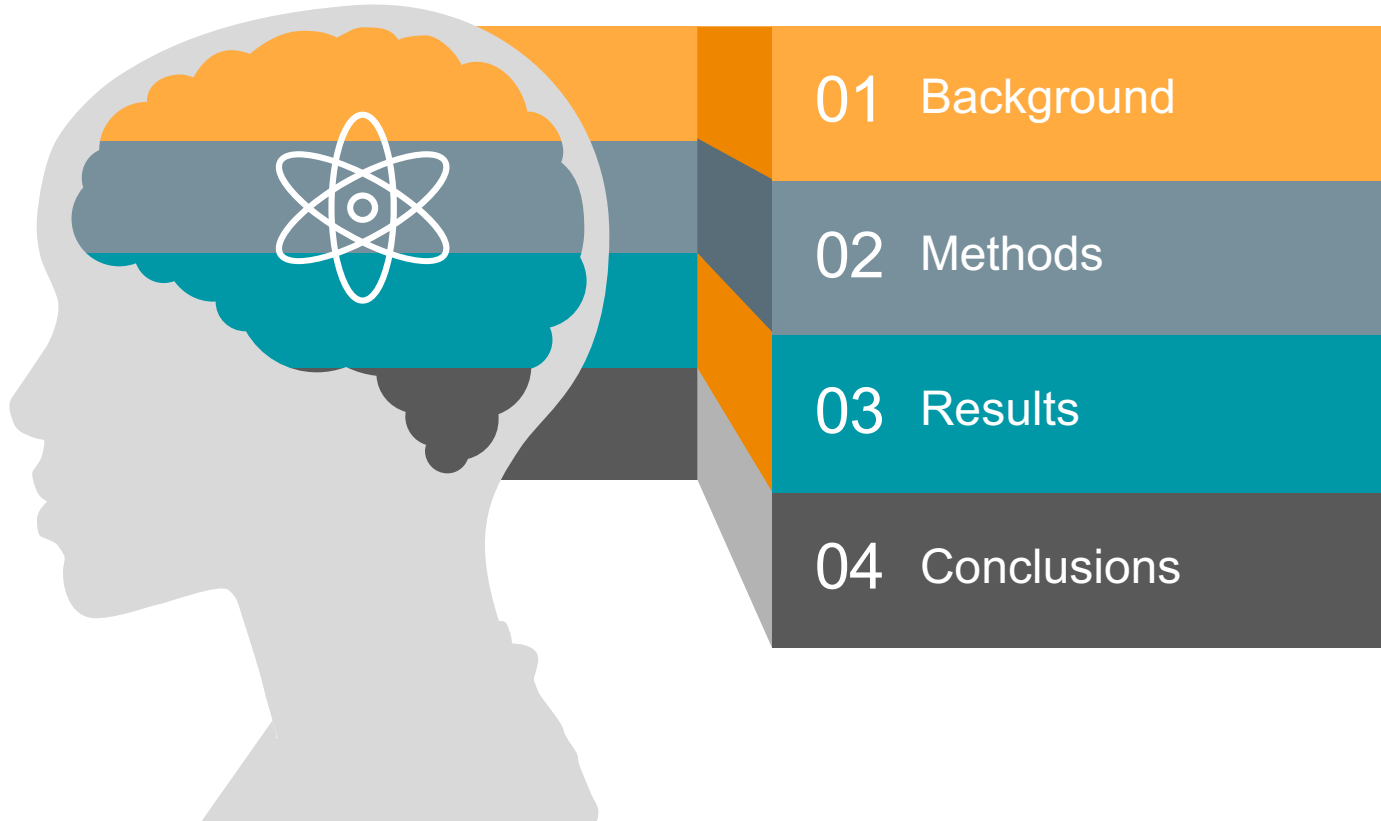
Purpose of an Abstract

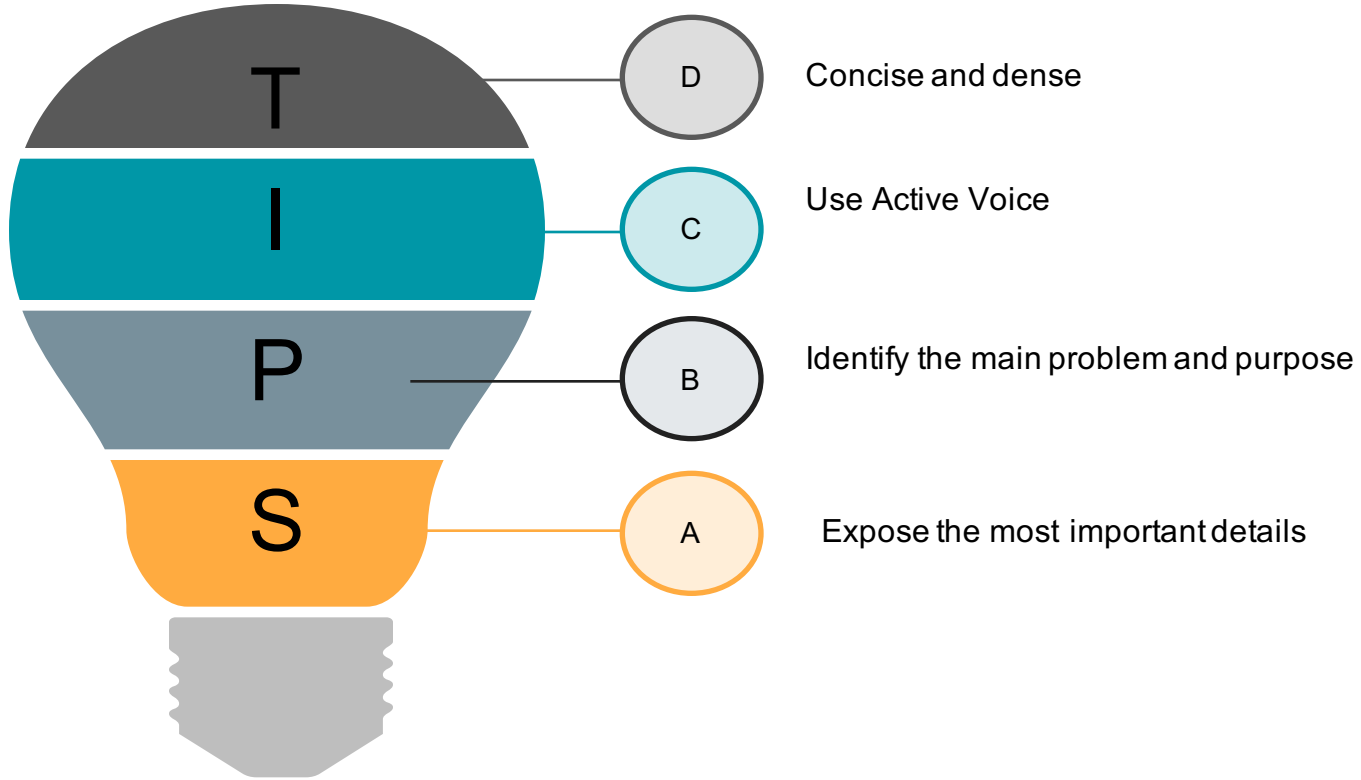
Survey the contents of the article very quickly



Evaluate the authors conclusions

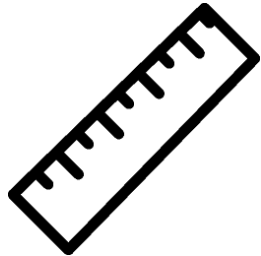
Sections of an Abstract





Mistakes to avoid

Hide significant information



Length (it should be between 150-200 words)

Including references for text, images or citations



Mistakes to avoid

Using the same sentence for the first line of the abstract on the introduction



Wasting words by repeating the title

Mistakes to avoid

Judging incorrectly what information is necessary and what is not



Not reviewing the abstract after writing the paper
